

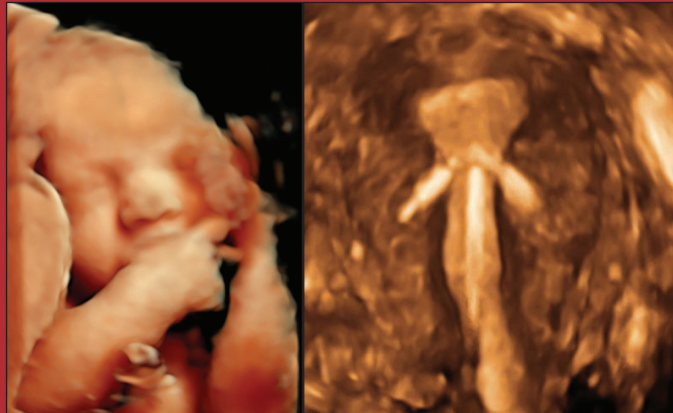

## COURSE DESCRIPTION

Ongoing development of new ultrasound techniques and equipment in areas of 2-D, 3-D, 4-D, Doppler, and invasive testing, make it challenging for practitioners of ultrasound to keep up to date and current in all aspects of ultrasound imaging. This advanced sonography course will provide obstetrical and gynecologic ultrasound practitioners with insights and new skills for the screening, diagnosis, and management of fetal anomalies using ultrasound. There will be in-depth focus on fetal and obstetrical abnormalities, and gynecologic imaging.

Exhibitors of ultrasound equipment and books will be present at the course.
